Medium Embroidery; silk thread and metallic thread on a plain-woven silk ground; glass, wood, gold paint

Description Needlework picture worked in green, blue-green, dark medium and light blue, tan, cream, pink, and red silk threads with gold metallic thread on a plain-woven cream-colored silk ground using a satin stitch and other stitches.

Basic Detail Report

The center of the picture shows a small, shallow beehive on a small hill. Above the beehive are bows and swagged ribbon embroidered with metallic thread. Below the beehive is a floral vine that curves up to meet the ribbon. The picture is behind glass (.c) that is painted black and gold at the edges; each corner has a gold painted star. The gilded wooden frame (.b, original) consists of several shallow moldings including a beaded molding. Stitches: The primary stitch is satin stitch; it also includes long and short, encroaching satin, flat and outline. Condition: The backing is replaced. The silk ground is scratched at the top center.
