

## **Title Woman's Shoe**

Date about 1820-1825

Primary Maker Unknown

Medium Hand-stitched and pegged leather

Description Slit-vamp tie work shoe, probably for a woman. The throatline appears to have been square originally. The shoe is straight, with a low, pegged heel; the sole is made in two parts, with the waist overlapping the forepart. Dimensions Primary Dimensions (length x height x width):  $9\,3/8\,x\,2\,1/4\,x\,3\,7/8$ in. (23.8 x 5.7 x 9.8cm)
