

Title Woman's Shoe

Date about 1850-1855

Primary Maker Unknown

Medium Hand-stitched leather, lined with linen, with silk binding and cotton string

Description White leather slipper, with long vamp, square throatline, rounded square toe, and flat, straight sole. The throatline is bound with tan-colored silk tape, with a narrow string under the tape to keep the leather from stretching.

The vamp is lined with plain-woven linen. The sock lining is matching white leather.

Dimensions Primary Dimensions (height x width x depth): $2 \times 2 \cdot 1/2 \times 9 \cdot 3/8$ in. (5.1 $\times 6.4 \times 23.8$ cm)
