

## **Title Girl's Boots**

Date about 1875

Primary Maker Unknown

Medium Machine-stitched leather and glazed cotton, with metal eyelets

Description Light brown shiny leather, front-lacing boots. The vamp seam across the instep and the top edge of the boots are scalloped. The toe shape is a rounded square and the stacked heels are about one inch high. The boot is laced through thirteen pairs of metal (appears to be brass) eyelets, backed by a matching leather tongue with a pinked top edge. The boots are lined along the top edge with white kid leather, and throughout the rest of the boot with plainwoven white glazed cotton. The sock lining is white leather.
