Title Woman's Boots

Date about 1875

Primary Maker Mary Ann Patten

Medium Machine-stitched leather, with silk and cotton linings, and leather-covered wooden heel

Description White kid leather button boots, with a Louis-shaped knock-on heel.

The button fly, which laps to the outside of the foot, has a scalloped edge, as does the top of the boot. Ten leather-covered, domed, shank buttons are used.

The toe shape of the boot is a rounded square. The upper is lined along the top edge with gold-colored silk, while the rest of the boot is lined with white twill-woven cotton. The sock lining is white plain-woven cotton. The soles are made for right and left feet. The top piece of the heel is nailed on.
