

## **Title Girl's Shoes**

Date about 1875

Primary Maker Alice M. Benjamin

Medium Machine-stitched leather, silk, cotton, and wood

Description White kid leather shoes, with narrow rounded square toe, short vamp, and low, Louis-shaped, knock-on heel. The vamp is decorated with a cream-colored satin bow. The quarters are lined with white leather, and the vamp is lined with tan twill-woven cotton. The sock lining is leather. The soles are made for right and left feet. The top piece of the heel is nailed on with gold-tone metal pegs.

Dimensions Primary Dimensions (height x width x depth):  $3 \frac{1}{8} \times 2 \frac{1}{8} \times 7 \frac{3}{4}$  in. (7.9 x 5.4 x 19.7cm)
