

Title Woman's Clogs

Date 1740-1770

Primary Maker Unknown

Medium Hand-stitched leather, with wood and with linen or hempen thread

Description Dark leather clog, made to slip over a woman's shoe. The sole is flat,
with a single layer of leather to act as a heel. The interior of the clog has a steplike design to accomodate the heel of the dress shoe; it is leather over wood. The
vamp has two short tabs which meet at the top of the foot; they are punched for
a ribbon tie. The leather is decoratively cut in two semicircles above the tabs.

The toe shape is oval. Two rounded extensions of leather rise from the heel area.

The sole is straight, without distinction for right or left.

Dimensions Primary Dimensions (height x width x depth): $17/8 \times 31/2 \times 81/4$ in. (4.8 x 8.9 x 21cm)
