

## **Title Woman's Shoes**

Date 1905-1910

Primary Maker Simmons Company

Medium Machine-stitched leather and cotton, with plastic eyelets, silk ribbon ties, and leather-covered wooden heel

Description Light blue, open-tab shoe, with pointed toe and Louis heel. The shoe ties over the instep with a blue satin ribbon, laced through a single pair of white plastic eyelets; the tabs are narrow, about one inch wide. The quarters are lined with white suede leather; the vamp is lined with white twill-woven cotton. The sock lining is white leather. The soles are shaped for the right and left foot, with a long, narrow waist.
