## Title Appliqué Quilt

Date 1840-1860

Primary Maker Unknown

Medium Hand-stitched plain-woven cotton

Description Appliqué quilt in a Rose Wreath pattern variation. The quilt consists of a plain-woven white cotton top, batting, and backing that are joined with a hand-stitched quilted pattern. The appliquéd pattern consists of twelve wreaths made of dark green cotton, each with four deep red flowers that each has a

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yellow center. Three sides of the quilt have a border of red flowers on a green

vine. The quilt has an overall dense diamond grid quilting pattern with

concentric squares inside each wreath. Each edge of the quilt has straight grain

white cotton binding. Condition: The top of the quilt has some light stains,

especially along the bottom edge and left quarter. The backing is stained lightly

as well. The backing has at several small tears.
