

## **Title Girl's Dress**

Date about 1928

**Primary Maker Mavis French** 

Medium Machine-stitched cotton, embroidered cotton, cotton bobbin lace, metal snaps

Description This short-sleeved, loose, pink plain-woven cotton dress was constructed from a single piece of fabric, folded at the shoulders and sewn at the sides. Embroidery work decorating the front of the dress was done in black, white, pink, blue, and white cotton embroidery threads. Ruching at the shoulderline is created by three 3 1/4-inch rows of stitching. The hem is 1 1/4-inch wide. The neck and sleeve openings are edged with 3/8-inch bobbin lace.

## **Basic Detail Report**

The garment is closed on a 4 3/4-inch placket at the center back, with two 1/4-

inch metal snaps.

Hem (circumference): 40in. (101.6cm)
