Description This bib is off-white, made from a plain-woven cotton fabric. On the center front, there is an embroidered image of two owls (one large, $3 \times 13/4$ inches, and one small, $21/2 \times 11/4$ inches) sitting on a tree limb. Underneath is written "Owl ready for supper" in matching embroidery. All of the embroidered work was done in off-white yarn and is roughly $6 \times 43/4$ inches. Two off-white buttons made of shell serve as the closure at the back of the bib's neck piece. Dimensions Primary Dimensions (height x width): $133/4 \times 103/4$ in. $(34.9 \times 27.3 \times 27.$
