## Title Woman's Shoes

Medium Machine-stitched leather and cotton, with silk grosgrain ribbon, leather-covered wooden heel, and metal tacks

Description Bronze-colored leather women's dress shoes, with oval toe and 2 1/2-inch-high, straight and narrow Louis heels. The shoes are designed with a narrow open tab, tied with a brown silk grosgrain bow. A pointed tongue extends behind the tabs. The throatline is edged with a very narrow ribbed silk piping. The quarters and tongue are lined with beige leather; the vamp is lined with white twill-woven cotton. The sock lining is beige leather. The soles are shaped for the right and left foot, with a strong swing.
