

Title Woman's Boots

Date about 1910

Primary Maker Isham family

Medium Machine-stitched leather, wool, cotton, and silk, with enameled metal buttons, and metal tacks

Description Black whole-foxed, buttoned boots, with leather fox and rib-woven wool top. The boots have a high, rounded pointed toe with a decorative toe cap, and 1 1/2-inch stacked heels. The edge of the button fly is straight, and the top edge is straight, but slanted upwards towards the front of the boot. Eleven black, enameled, dome-shaped buttons close the top of the boot. The top edge of the boot and button fly are lined with black leather; the rest of the boot is

lined with white twill-woven cotton. The sock lining is brown leather, with an extra pad of white felt in the heel area. The sole is shaped for the right and left foot.
