

Title Boy's Socks

Date about 1908

Primary Maker Che Chiang Liang

Medium Hand-stitched white cotton

Description These Chinese socks are made of white cotton woven fabric. They are constructed with a slipper-like foot stitched to a 5-inch-long top, which is seamed front and back. The back seam of the top is open for about 2 1/2 inches to allow access for the foot. There is decoratively dashed top stitching along the seam lines of the foot piece. The sole is straight; it is closely quilted with an X in the center radiating out with concentric V's, then parallel diagonal lines. Dimensions Primary Dimensions (length x height x width): $8 \times 6 \times 27/8$ in. (20.3 $\times 15.2 \times 7.3$ cm)
