
Basic Detail Report



Title Round House, Armory Site, Hartford

Description Curved brick railroad building, with arched double wooden doors,
separated by what appear to be iron columns. The doors are numbered "2"

through "20". Railroad tracks lead to each door. A crane in the foreground with
cables and pulleys is apparently being used to excavate a large hole. Wooden
stairs lead down at the left. A pile of dirt is in the left foreground. A wooden shed
is at the right.
