

Title Camisole Embroidery Pattern

Date about 1910-1920

Primary Maker Holcombe family

Medium Printed cotton

Description Length of fine white cotton printed with an embroidery pattern for the neckline and armhole edges of a camisole. The edges were to be scalloped and the neckline to be worked with eyelets for a ribbon drawstring. Marks for a floral spray appear at the center front. The armholes are marked "34, 36, 38, 40" to note sizing.

Dimensions Primary Dimensions (height x width): 37 5/8 x 29 1/4in. (95.6 x 74.3 cm)
