Description The stone Gothic revival Wadsworth Atheneum museum building is at the left, with square towers, crenellations, recessed flattened pointed arches, and a porch. Trees, bushes, and a statue are on the grassy lawn. A fire hydrant, utility poles, and trolley poles are on the paved sidewalk. Automobiles are parked at the side of the paved street. Trolley tracks are in the road.
