

## **Title Dressing Jacket**

Date about 1935-1960

Primary Maker Battalino family

Medium Machine-stitched silk, with cotton rickrack and mother of pearl buttons Description Woman's dressing jacket of blue silk printed with scattered small bouquets of flowers and scattered single flowers. The jacket opens at center front; it fastens with five mother of pearl buttons. The button placket is edged with white rickrack. The neckline is high and round; the rounded collar is edged with rickrack. The sleeves are given a little fullness with darts at the top of the shoulder. They are short, 8 1/2 inches long, and edged with rickrack.
