

## **Title Petticoat**

Date about 1900-1910

Primary Maker Hofer family

Medium Machine-stitched cotton and rayon with a hook and eye

Description Woman's petticoat, cut in a circle for a broad flare. The fabric is a

coarsely woven cotton, very stiffly starched. The bottom edge is raw. The

waistband is 3/4 inch wide and is made of ecru rayon. It fastens with a single
hook and eye.
