

## Basic Detail Report

Date about 1920-1935 Primary Maker Mary Frances Pope Medium Hand-stitched silk with cotton filet lace Description Woman's slip of ecru silk satin. The slip is constructed of a length of silk, sewn into a tube so that the selvages provide the finish on the top and bottom edges. Deep knife pleats are taken on each side. The top is edged with a 2 3/4-inch-wide band of filet lace in a rose pattern. A rectangular panel of this lace is set at center front. Silk ribbons are used for the shoulder straps. Horizontal darts are taken from the side seams to fit the bust. Dimensions Primary Dimensions (length x width across top x hem diameter): 44 x 16 1/4 x 51in. (111.8 x 41.3 x 129.5cm)
