## **Basic Detail Report**

Medium Slip (.b): Machine-stitched rayon, cotton, and silk, with metal snaps.

Description Slip (.b): Woman's below-knee-length slip of white rayon, closely fitted in the top. The left side opening fastens with six metal snaps. The shoulder straps are narrow strips of cream-colored cotton. The bottom edge of the rayon is cut in wide scallops, sewn to a bias-cut flounce (8 1/4-inches-deep) of cream-colored organdy.

Dimensions Component (Slip: length excluding shoulder straps x width across top):  $46\ 3/4\ x\ 16\ 1/2$ in. ( $118.7\ x\ 41.9$ cm) Other (Slip: approximate width across bottom): 39in. (99.1cm)
