Floodwaters of the Connecticut River at the mouth of the Park River are shown, with the Colt dome and Dutch Point power station visible in the distance. Streets shown include Sisson Avenue and Sheldon Street (near the Hartford Electric Light Co. building at #410). Also, garages behind Wethersfield Avenue homes are shown.
