Medium Machine-stitched cotton with mother of pearl buttons

Description Girl's dress of white cotton with a square neckline bordered by whitework embroidery in a geometric design. The dress is box-pleated into the neckline border and into the shoulders and falls straight to the hem. The dress

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opens under the leftmost pleat and fastens with buttons which are hidden under the pleat. The sleeves are short and are gathered at the shoulder. The sleeve openings are bordered with the whitework band. The back of the dress is also box-pleated into the neckline border. There are belt loops mounted on the sides.
