Description Small child's slip of white cotton, with the skirt gathered into a plain bodice. The neckline is low and round; this and the armholes are edged with machine-made bobbin lace. The full skirt is ornamented with an insertion of handmade torchon lace. The bottom is edged with a self-fabric ruffle trimmed with scalloped torchon lace. The center back of the slip opens for about twelve inches and fastens with four mother of pearl buttons on the bodice. Dimensions Primary Dimensions (length x width across bodice): 21 1/4 x 11 1
