Title Infant's Slip

Date about 1912 to 1917

Primary Maker Mrs. R. L. Slocum

Medium Machine-stitched cotton, with mother of pearl buttons

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Description Very small infant's slip of white cotton. The round neckline and armholes are edged with bobbin lace. The skirt is gathered into the bottom of the bodice. The bottom of the skirt has four narrow tucks above a whipped flounce, edged with lace. The slip opens at center back for a length of $8 \frac{3}{4}$ inches. It fastens with two mother of pearl buttons.
