

Medium Lithography; printer's ink and watercolor on wove paper Description Fire apparatus consisting of a heavy four wheeled wagon with a ropes and a handle at left to be used in pulling and long poles to used in pumping water by hand. The number "4" and a lantern are on the side of the wagon. A separate two-wheeled hose cart is at the right. A long metal hook at the front of the hose cart apparently served to connect it to the pump. Dimensions Primary Dimensions (image height x width): 4 7/8 x 12 3/4in.
