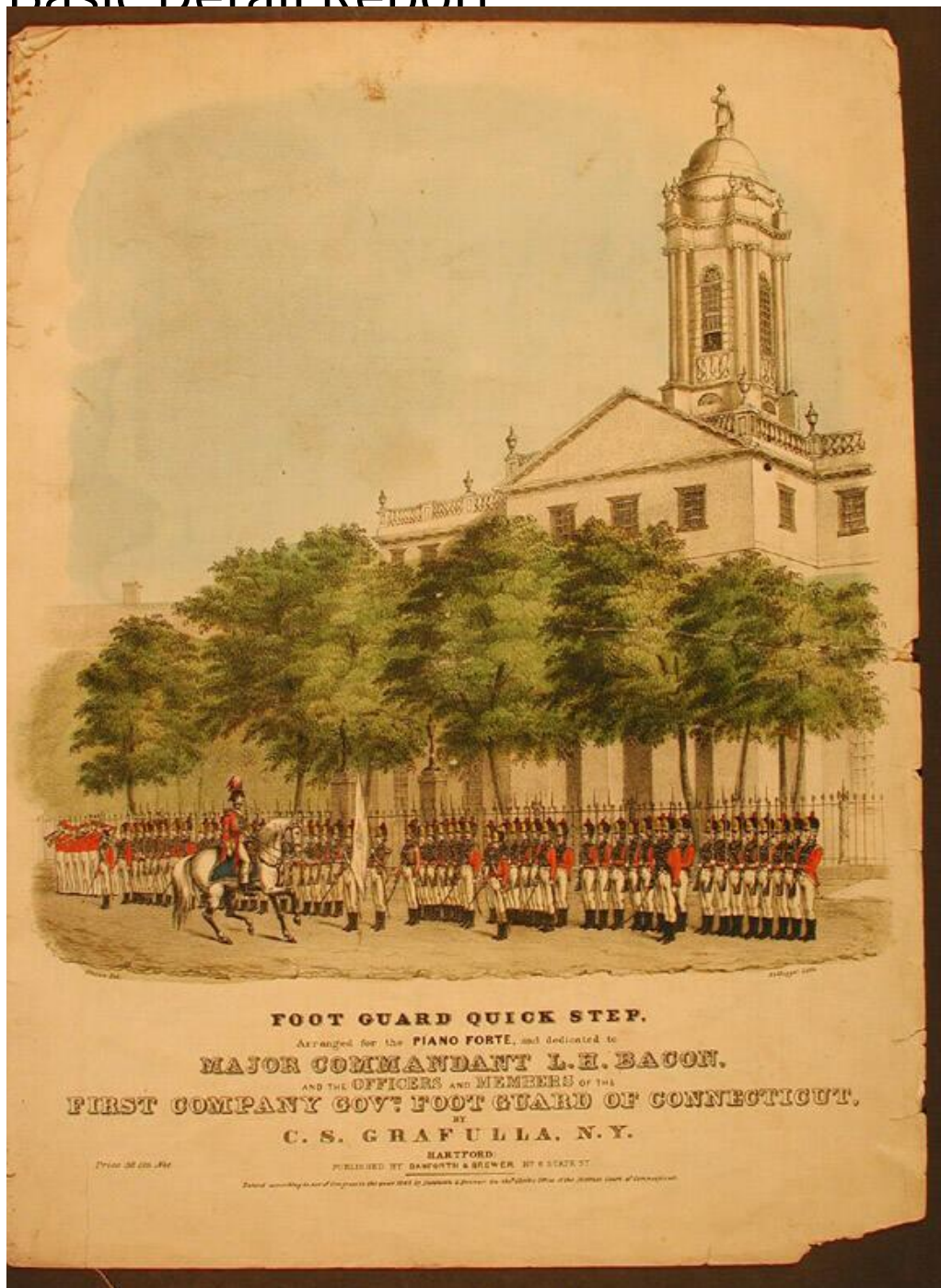

Description Sheet music with a view of the Governor's Foot Guard assembled in

A balustrade and ornamental urns are on the roof. The lower part of the building is largely hidden by trees and an iron fence with stone posts.
