

## Title Infant's Bib

Date about 1850-1875

Primary Maker Martha L. Woodworth

Medium Hand-stitched linen

Description Infant's bib of white linen woven in a bird's-eye twill. The bib has armholes and opens at center back. The bib is shaped with rounded corners. There is a point at the center front neckline. The outer edge is scalloped and finished with buttonhole stitching, then embroidered with scallops pointed away from the armhole.

Dimensions Primary Dimensions (length x width ): 7  $1/2 \times 14 \times 7/8$  in. (19.1 x 37.8 cm)
