Description Articles include cruets in a stand, a tureen, a basket, knives in a box with a hinged lid, a tea service, including teapots, creamer, and sugar bowl, a covered dish with a cow on it (possibly a butter dish), cups, goblets, a fruit bowl, and other serving bowls and dishes, and condiment containers. Most articles are apparently made of silver, but some appear to include components of glass or crystal.

Dimensions Primary Dimensions (image height x width):  $7 \frac{1}{4} \times 10 \frac{3}{4}$ in. (18.4 x 27.3cm) Sheet (height x width):  $9 \frac{3}{8} \times 12 \frac{1}{2}$ in. (23.8 x 31.8cm)
