

# Basic Detail Report



## Title Corset

Date about 1892

Primary Maker Lucy Fiddis Griffith

Medium Machine-stitched silk, with silk tapes, machine-made cotton lace, steel boning and hooks, and baleen boning

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Description Woman's corset of cream-colored silk. The corset laces up the

center back, while the front fastens with short, steel pegs fitted in keyhole eyes.

The individual pieces of boning are covered with cream-colored satin. The

waistline is defined with a horizontal strip of satin stitched underneath the

boning; this strip is split and splayed toward the center front edges. The top

edge of the corset is decorated with a ruffle of lace with a silk ribbon run through

the center and tied in a loopy bow on the proper right side of the front opening.

Both the top and bottom edges are bound with the cream-colored satin. The silk

tape which is laced through the metal grommets of the center back opening has

metal tips.
