

## **Title Girl's Dress**

Date about 1850-1855

Primary Maker Mary Marilla Leggett

Medium Hand-stitched cotton, with thread-covered bone or horn buttons, handmade bobbin lace, and hand embroidery

Description Girl's dress of white cotton, with a wide neckline edged with bobbin lace. The bodice has vertical insertions of bobbin lace, and the short sleeves have two rows of lace insertion and an edging of whitework embroidery. The full

skirt is gathered into the waistline. It is decorated with three rows of lace insertion. The hem is edged with three-inch-deep scalloped whitework embroidery. The center back opening extends 11 1/2 inches and fastens with a drawstring at the neckline and five thread-covered buttons (one is missing). The waistband is lined with self-fabric.
