## Title Girl's Dress

Date about 1880-1890

Primary Maker Unknown

Medium Machine-stitched cotton, with mother of pearl buttons

Description Girl's dress of white cotton, with a dropped waistline and high,

round neckline. The bodice is decorated with three vertical rows of whitework

embroidery insertion on both front and back. The two-piece sleeves are slightly

curved and are set smoothly into the armscye, which rests at the natural

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shoulder. The sleeves end in a 2 1/4-inch-deep, whipped ruffle of scalloped whitework embroidery, headed by a band around the wrist of whitework matching that used on the bodice. This whitework insertion encircles the dropped waistline. The skirt is decorated with rows of tucks and ruched selffabric on either side of a band of whitework insertion. The bottom is edged with scalloped whitework, 3 1/4-inch-deep, with a feathery frond design. The center back opening extends 15 1/2 inches, to the dropped waistline, and fastens with ten mother of pearl buttons. Dimensions Primary Dimensions (length x width across shoulders): 31 x 11in.
