Description Designs for a stone Gothic revival church include front elevations, rear elevations, side elevations, longitudinal sections, main floor plans, basement plans, heating plans, and details of window frames. Some drawings include the locations of the baptistery, boiler room, confessionals, chapels, closets, a coatroom, kitchen, lobby, narthex, nave, sacristy, and social hall with chairs. Construction plans indicate the use of steel trusses.
