Other dead and wounded men lie nearby. Cannon balls and a box of charges are near the cannon. Other soldiers charge from the right, accompanied by an officer on a spotted horse. Two of these soldiers wear Zouave uniforms. One man carries an American flag. The Rebel army is in the background, partially obscurred by cannon smoke.
