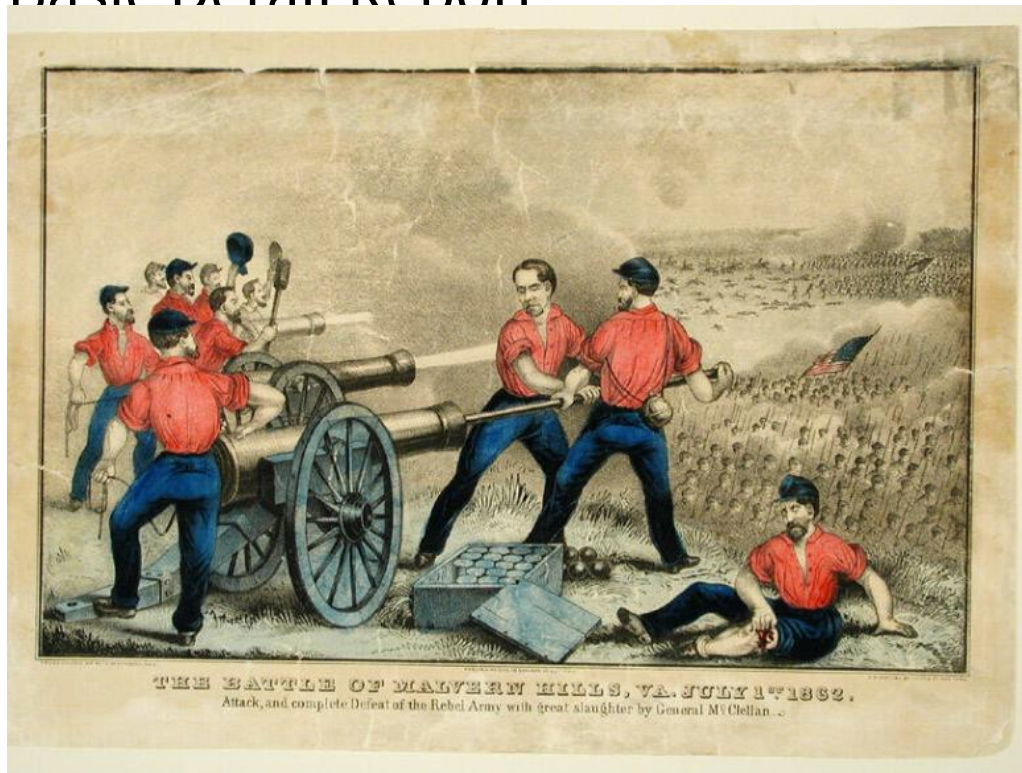


# Basic Detail Report



**Title** The Battle of Malvern Hills, Va. July 1st. 1862.

**Date** 1862

**Primary Maker** E.B. & E.C. Kellogg

**Medium** Lithography; printer's ink and watercolor on wove paper

**Description** At the left, three cannon crews are firing their guns. The men wear red shirts, blue trousers, and military beaked caps. All have beards and mustaches.
