Description Designs for a proposed laundry building for the city of Hartford include front elevations, end elevations, cross sections, and plans of the laundry floor. Three plans are identified as rough drafts. Proposed building was to be constructed of brick, with standard steel sash, felt and slag or gravel roofs, hung ceilings, and ventilators. Plans include a washing, extracting and tumbling room, a room for ironing boards and presses, a sorting room, a locker room, a women's rest room, a women's toilet room, a women's wash room, a men's room, a men's toilet room, and a men's wash room, an office, a tunnel, and an elevator shaft.
