## **Title Man's Bathing Suit**

Date about 1930s

Primary Maker Christopher Battalino

Medium Machine-stitched wool

Description Man's bathing suit of black wool. The suit has a low, scooped neckline at front and back and equally scooped armholes. The top extends in a short skirt over the attached, short-legged bottoms. The shoulder straps have been shorted by overlapping them at the top, and the armholes have been taken in by stitching a small dart at the lower front. There is a large oval patch on the proper left side of the skirt. All of these alterations appear to have been done at the time of the original wearing.
