## Title Pince-nez and Eyeglass Case

Date about 1920-1940

Primary Maker Beatrice Fox

Medium (.a): ground glass lenses, 14 karat white gold, plastic; (.b): silk damask fabric-covered metal case lined with suede leather and edged in 14 karat white gold

Description Rimless pince-nez (.a) with a white gold bridge and asymmetrical (almost circular), clear lenses. The bridge has plastic nose pads. Hard-sided spectacle case covered in silk damask fabric woven in shades of chartreuse, blue and salmon lined with brown suede (.b) with a spring closure. The edge of the closure is edged with 14-karat gold trim.
