

quiet lane in the park. From Hazardville, a view of Fairlawn Avenue, with houses visible. From Windsor, a view of a schoolhouse. Other views outside Connecticut or unknown include: a horse-drawn carriage on a dirt street on Cedar Mt.; people rowing in a boat; a view out onto a large body of water, with a masted ship in the distance; and The Marsh House. Views from the Jefferson County, New York, area: a Saint Lawrence lighthouse; a hotel called Eveleigh House in Sackets Harbor, New York, with an automobile parked in the front; and a view on the Black River. Portraits include: a group of young women in long white dresses with the notation "Northfield / 1906" "Girl Graduates"; a group of young women outside near a table set for dining, with a tablecloth and glassware marked 'College chums'; an unidentified woman holding a hat on her head; and a group of young men and women having a picnic in East Granby. Also, interior shots of a cat on a table.
