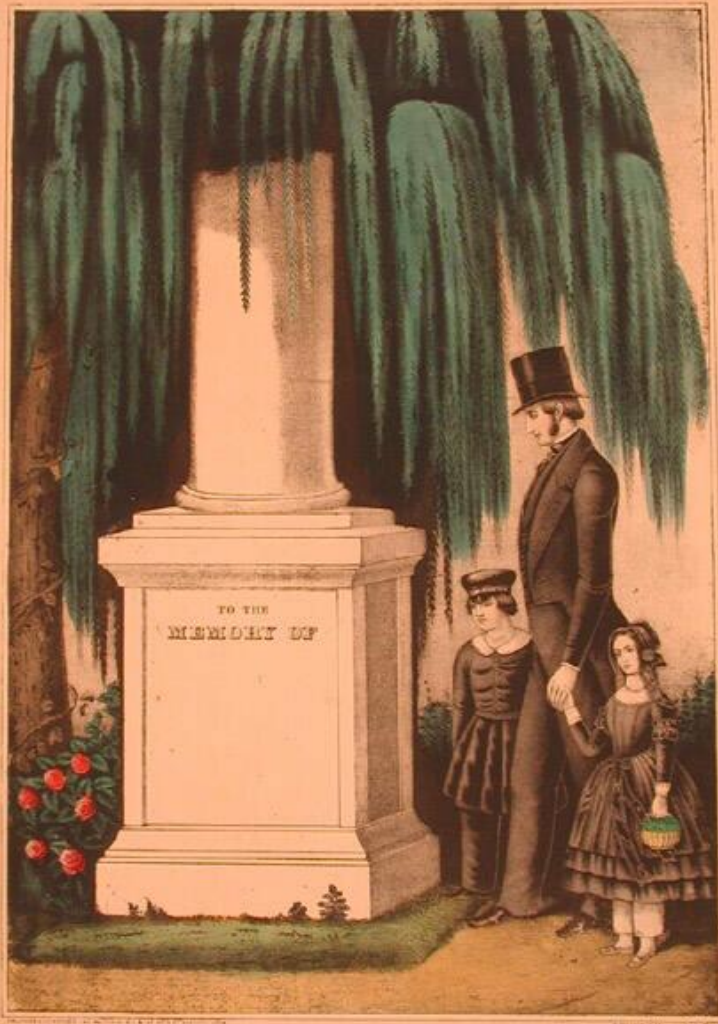

wears a cap, a jacket with a pleated skirt, and pants. A weeping willow grows at

the far left, with its branches hanging over the monument. Ivy grows on its trunk

and a rose bush in bloom grows beside it. Grass and small plants surround the

base of the monument.
