Description A large number of American soldiers on horseback charge towards

wounded on the ground. An artillery crew attends a mounted cannon nearby. A
small pile of cannonballs lies near the wheel of the cannon carriage. Mexican
cavalry charge from the right. A wounded man lies in the right foreground. A
wounded horse is at the far right, and another wounded soldier staggers
towards the right. An additional cannon and crew and infantry troops are in the
