

## **Title Dish**

Primary Maker Hammersley & Co.

Medium Mold-formed porcelain with overglaze gilding and enamel in gold, pink, blue, yellow, and green

Description Shallow porcelain dish in the shape of an enlongated shell. The edge of the white dish is decorated with a solid line of gilding that spreads and fades onto the surface. Then the dish is decorated in an overall pattern of small clusters of three gold dots intersperced with roses, pansies, and forget-me-nots in pink, blue, and yellow.
