

Title Teacup and Saucer

Medium Mold-formed porcelain with gilding and overglaze enamels in blue, green, and red

Description Round, porcelain teacup (.a) and saucer (.b) with gilding and overglaze enamels in green, blue, and red. The rims of both the teacup and saucer are gilded. The rim of the saucer and inside and outside rim of the teacup have a border of blue and red flowers and green leaves on a vine. There is additional gilding on the handle and four areas of the foot of the teacup. Dimensions Component (height x width including handle x depth of teacup): $2\ 1\ /4 \times 4\ 1/2 \times 3\ 5/8$ in. $(5.7 \times 11.4 \times 9.2$ cm) Component (diameter of saucer): $5\ 1/2$ in. (14cm)
