Hardware, the Birmingham Iron Foundry, the Derby Lumber Co., the Derby Trucking Co., the First Congregational Church in Derby, and the birthplace of Isaac Hull in Shelton. Other views include trolley tracks, railroad tracks, and the Derby railroad station. Bridges include the Concrete Bridge in

during a spring freshet. Dams include the Ousatonic Dam, which is shown
