with stylized scrolls and leaves. Imperfections in the ceramic appear as brown

dots on the surface of the plate. There is only one very small chip on the rim.

Although there are no marks on the bottom of the plate, the marks from the

three small stands used to separate this plate from the one below it in the kiln

are clearly visible.
