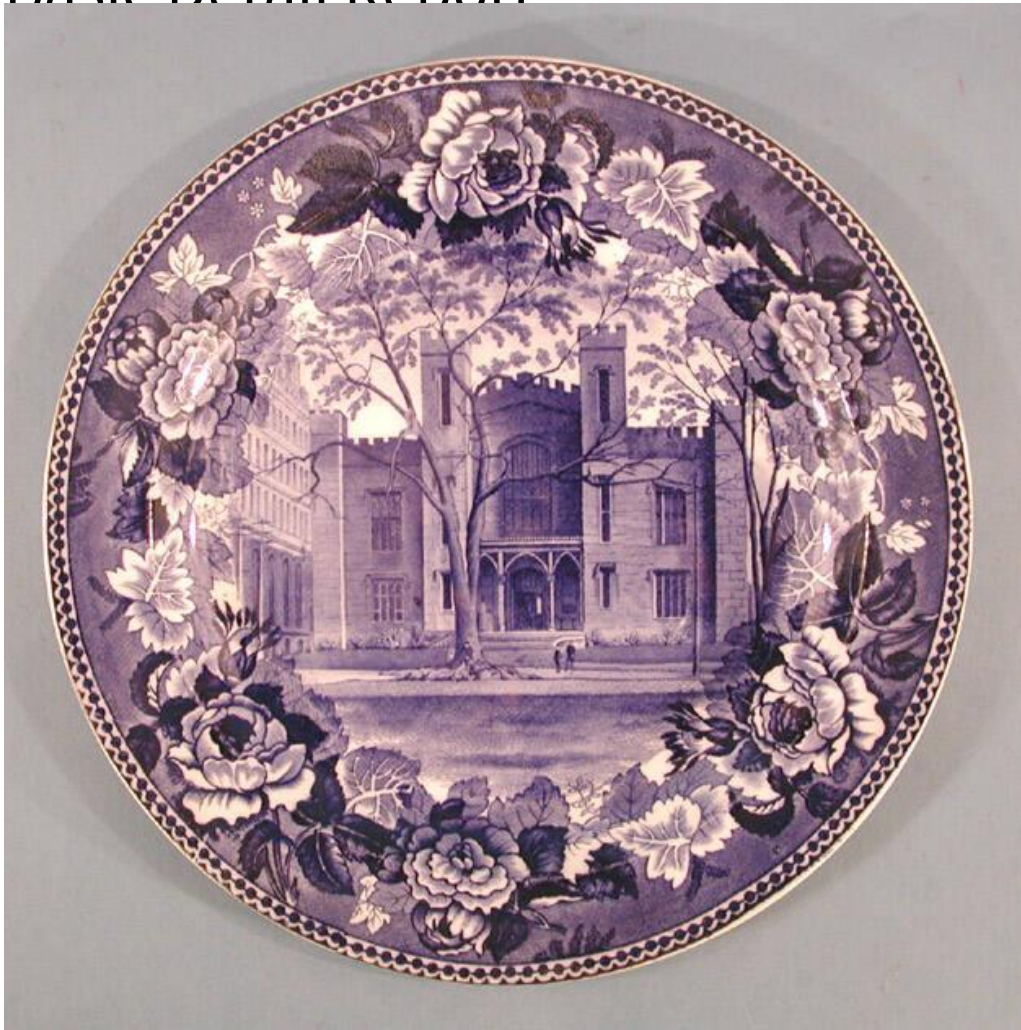

blue. A narrow border at the outer edge of the rim consists of a scalloped white

line and a series of blue circles creating a geometric pattern. There is light

crazing over all the surfaces of the plate.
