

Title Architectural Tiles

Date about 1735-1745

Primary Maker Governor George Wyllys

Medium Press-molded tin-glazed earthenware with cobalt blue and overglaze enamels in black, green, orange, and yellow

Description Group of eight tin-glazed earthenware tiles with hand-painted decoration in cobalt blue and overglaze enamels in black, green, orange, and yellow. Each of the eight tiles are decorated with one of three different floral patterns, showing blue, yellow, and orange flowers on a black stem with green

leaves. Each corner of the tiles are decorated with three blue bands. The tiles are said to have been installed around a fireplace. Four of the eight tiles are not in one piece. Two tiles, .4 and .6, have a horizontal break in the middle, breaking both into two pieces. The other two broken tiles, .7 and .8, are each in three pieces.
