Medium Mechanically-molded ironstone with underglaze blue decoration

Description Round, ironstone plate with an underglaze cobalt blue transfer-printed pattern and border. The plate has an undulating rim and a raised pattern of small flowers that follows the edge of the rim. The circular pattern in the center of the plate is titled, "HISTORICAL CHARTER OAK./ CONECTICUT CHARTER CONCEALED IN TREE, A.D. 1687-1689./ TREE BLOWN DOWN AUG 31ST 1856". The pattern shows a large tree, leaning to the left, behind a fenced-in

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lawn. A white house sits at the far end of the yard. This is surrounded by a border of five large flowers, evenly spaced around the rim, with scrolls, flowers, and

leaves between. There are a few light scratches in the glaze on the top surface of

the plate, and several spots of dirt adhered to the bottom.
