## **Title Water Department Administration Building, Hartford**

Description Drawings include plans for foundation, basement, first floor, first floor framing, roof, attic and elevation for front, rear, side, stable, waiting room, elevator. Also, details of window grill, heavyweight steel casement shaft, sewer levels and cross section of cross of coal bunker, vault. Plans include yard forman, meter testing room, coal bunker, stock storage, garage, machine shop, repari shiop, blacksmith, pipe fitting shop, tar felt and slag roof, wagon shed, cost accounting, draughting room, hay loft, garage trusses, stable and attic storage. Elevations show 1 story, 15 bay building with flat roof. There are double windows with skylight and keystone lintels divided by doric columns. There is a hipped roof over the center bay divided by a copper cornice, and the entrance features a portico and pediment. Scale of drawings is  $1/8" = 1'0"$ .
