Title Public Bath House, Hartford

Medium Drawings; black ink, red and black pencil on paper, tracing paper or cardboard

Description Drawings include plans for cellar, first floor, second floor and elevations for north side, front side and south side. Also, details of transverse section and windows. Plans include old sewer, cellar windows, coal bin, boiler room, men's shower room, men's waiting room, new stairs, women's shower, women's waiting room and basic sketch of rooms and exterior shape. Elevations show a five bay, two story building with flat roof and lower double hung sash windows with multipaned hinged transom and flat lintel. Also four over four with double hung pivoted sash are on the facade with an (old) door frame (to be remaining with transom, but new glazed glass door). Details show windows between waiting room and shower room stationary sash and pivoted transom.

Scale for drawings is $1/4" = 1'0"$.
